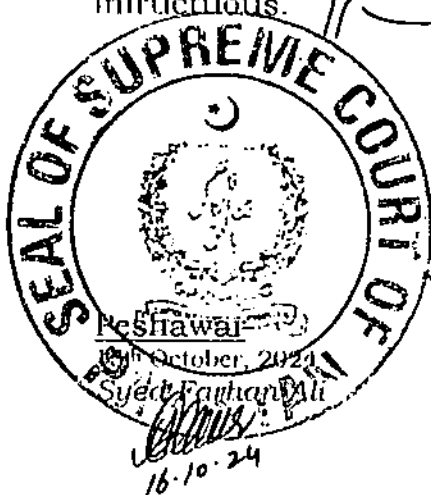

ORDER

Yahya Afridi, J.- Learned counsel for the respondent, present before us, states that a *de-novo* inquiry had been carried out, which has finally culminated in conditional reinstatement into service of the respondent, which when challenged before the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal in Appeal No.4903/2021 was allowed vide judgment dated 14.10.2021.
