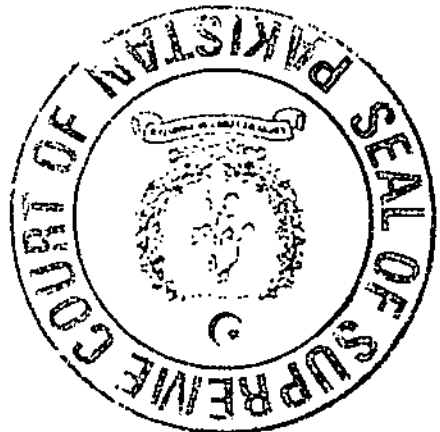
3. In view of the above we find the present petition to be
