During the course of arguments, the learned counsel for the appellant referred to paragraph 'b' of the grounds of reply, wherein 248 days of leave from 21.05.2015 to 23.01.2016 were treated as full-pay leave, and 131 days from 24.01.2016 to 02.06.2016 were treated as leave without pay. The appellant was reinstated into service on 03.06.2016. The respondents contended that the required service of six months was not rendered by the appellant in 2016, and therefore, he is not entitled to the increments due in December 2016. As matter relates to calculation of and financial in nature, therefore, Secretary Finance is directed to depute a well conversant officer to assist the Tribunal for reaching just and proper decision.
