



1. Learned counsel for the applicant present. Mr. Arshad Azam, Assistant Advocate General for the respondents present. Arguments on restoration application heard and record perused.

2. The Service Appeal bearing No. 800/2024 was dismissed for non-compliance of order dated 18.09.2024. The appellant submitted application for attested copy on 20.09.2024 which was delivered to him on 11.10.2024, hence preferred the instant restoration application on 11.10.2024. The application is well within time and learned Assistant Advocate General has got no objection on restoration of appeal. The application for restoration of service appeal is supported by duly sworn affidavit. Law also favours adjudication on merit by avoiding technicalities.

3. The restoration application in hand is, therefore, accepted subject to costs of Rs. 3000/- and the appeal is restored to its original number. To come up for preliminary hearing on 25.11.2024 before the S.B P.P given to the parties.
