

- 6- In the memo of appeal the word petitioner is used but there is no provision in Service Tribunal Act/rules for using the word of petitioner in the appeal.





APPEAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE SERVICE TRIBUNAL ACT 1974
AGAINST THE ILLEGAL STOPPAGE OF SALARY

Respectfully Sheweth: The appellant is humbly submitted as under:

1. That Appellant being an eligible candidate, appointed as Class-IV on dated 18-02-2022 through Employment Exchange Commission on regular basis and after joining his department, serves his duty with great zeal and zest, but all of the sudden from 01-10-2022 salary of petitioner was stopped despite in attendance on regular basis since appointment till date with a satisfactory service record.
(Copy of Employment Exchange Certificates and Appointment Order, Medical and Arrival Report is attached as Annex-A & B)
2. That feeling aggrieved from the unlawful act of respondents, appellant filed online complaint through web before the Provincial Ombudsman KPK, after submitting reply on behalf of respondent, the said complaint was accepted vide order dated 27-06-2023 with direction to release salary of appellant forthwith. (Copy of order is attached as Annex-C)
3. That despite the strict directions, petitioner approached the respondents one after another and time and again requested orally as well as through written applications cum Legal Notice to release his salary and obey the order of Provincial Ombudsman KPK but in vain.
(Copy of Applications, Legal Notice is attached as Annex-D)

4. That feeling aggrieved from the unlawful act of respondents appellant filed departmental Appeal / Representation to respondent but they failed to even respond hence the instant appeal on following grounds:

(Copy of DA/ Rep: alongwith Post receipt is attached as Annex-E)

Grounds:

- A. That the stoppage of salary of a civil servant unilaterally, who is still in attendance on regular basis, can in no case be condoned. Reliance placed from **Hadith of Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H.)** that the **wages of a worker be paid before his sweat dries up.** Stoppage of salary is in clear violation of the fundamental rules and against the **fundamental rights guaranteed under the Constitution of Pakistan, including the right to livelihood of women, child and family.** Supreme Court of Pakistan time and again held that any adverse action against a civil servant, such as stoppage of salary, must be preceded by a lawful procedure and the affected party must be given an opportunity of hearing in line with the principles of natural justice.
- B. That Appellant salary has been stopped unlawfully and without any prior notice or without following the prescribed procedures, ensuring a lawful inquiry or hearing, causing significant financial hardship and mental agony. In case of **Mst. Shumaila Latif Vs Government of KPK** reported as **2017 PLC (CS) Note 14 Peshawar**, Honorable Court ruled that withholding the salary of a government employee without providing a valid reason and without issuing a proper notice is contrary to the principles of justice. **As long as a person after appointment is working in department his salary cannot be stopped.**
- C. That the stoppage of the salary took effect from October 2022 without any formal order or justification being communicated to the Appellant. In case reported as **2000 PLC (CS) 784**, Honorable Court held that **if the employee is made to work without payment of salary it would be against the injunction of islam which envisages payment of wages before sweat of toil is dried up.** This act would also violate the principle of policy contained in Chapter 2, Part-II and Article 3 of the Constitution of Pakistan 1973.
- D. That despite repeated requests made to the concerned authorities, the Appellant has not received any response or explanation regarding the stoppage of salary. In case of reported as **2006 PLC (CS) 402 Service Tribunal Sindh**, court ruled that salary is a vested right of a civil servant, and its stoppage without any valid reason or lawful authority is a violation of


the employee's fundamental rights. The court emphasized the importance of a transparent and lawful process before taking any adverse action against a civil servant.

- E. That the stoppage of the Appellant salary constitutes a violation of his fundamental rights to a fair livelihood as guaranteed by the Constitution. In case reported as **2005 PLC (CS) Service Tribunal Sindh**, Court held that salary is a part of a civil servant's terms of employment, and its arbitrary stoppage amounts to a violation of the right to livelihood.

Prayer:

In light of the above facts and grounds, the Appellant humbly prays that this Honorable Tribunal may graciously be pleased to:

1. Direct the Respondents to immediately release the stopped salary of the Appellant from October 2022 up-till present, along with arrears and benefits.
2. Declare the stoppage of salary as illegal, unconstitutional, and contrary to the service rules and fundamental rights guaranteed under the Constitution of Pakistan 1973.
3. Direct the Respondents to refrain from taking any further adverse action against the Appellant without due process and compliance with the law.
4. Grant any other relief deemed fit by this Honorable Tribunal in the interest of justice and equity.

Terms & Conditions:-

1. He is domiciled in District Mardan.
2. His appointment is purely on temporary basis for a probation period of initially one-year and is liable to terminate at any time without assigning any notice or reason.
3. He will not be entitled to any TA/DA for Medical examination and joining the first appointment.
4. His appointment will be subject to medical fitness for Govt. Service.

THE COMPLAINT

Mr. Shahzeb r/o District Mardan lodged the instant complaint stating that he has applied for the post of Class-IV in Health Department Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Later on he was appointed against the post of Lady Health Worker and currently working at RHC Manga District Mardan since February 2022. The complainant further added that he is a regular employee of Health Department but his salary has been stopped by the department for last four months while he is regularly performing his duty and also marking attendance on daily basis. He has requested the department for release of salary but to no avail. He approached this Forum for redressal of his grievance.

REPLY OF THE AGENCY

Notices in terms of section 10 (4) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Provincial Ombudsman Act, 2010 were issued to the Secretary to Govt. of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Health Department, Director General, Health Services, Peshawar and District Health Officer, Mardan to meet the allegations contained in the complaint and to submit reply including rebuttal, if any. In response, District Health Officer Mardan submitted written reply intimating that case of the complainant 31 (Thirty One) others Class-IV employees cases are under inquiry as they are drawing salaries against Lady Health Worker posts. Action will be taken as soon as inquiry in the case is finalized.

REJOINDER

Report of the Agency was shared with the complainant for his feedback/rejoinder. In response he denied the stance of the Agency and reiterated his earlier version.

HEARING

To ascertain the factual position, case was fixed for hearing on 13/06/2023. Dr. Absan

FINDINGS

After going through the record placed on file and hearing conducted in the instant case, it has been observed that the representative of the Agency failed to defend his stance. He has admitted that complainant was selected on the post of LIW and was getting salary but suddenly his salary was stopped. Although complainant is still attending his department but without salary. Therefore, viewpoint of the department is not convincing and cannot be accepted. Hence stoppage of salary is against the rules. It is recommended that the department shall release salary of the complainant forthwith.

These recommendations should be implemented within 45 days of the receipt of these findings under intimation to this Secretariat within the said period.

NOTE: Defiance / Non-compliance shall warrant disciplinary proceeding in terms of Section 14 sub-Section 6 & 7 of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Provincial Ombudsman Act 2010 whereby, the government will take necessary action for ensuring good governance.

Under the instruction of my client namely Mr. Shahzeb, I served on your good self this Legal Notice informing your good self as follows:



