JOINT PARA WISE REPLY/COMMENTS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENTS NO. 1 TO 5

Respectfully Sheweth,

Para wise Reply, on behalf of Respondents No. 1 to 5, is as under:

Preliminary Objections:

- 1. That the Appellant has no cause of action.
- 2. That the Appellant has got no locus-standi to institute the present Service Appeal.
- 3. That, the Appeal of the appellant is not maintainable in its present form.
- 4. That, the Appeal of the appellant is bad for non-joinder and mis-joinder of parties.
- 5. That, the Appellant has been estopped by his own conduct to file the instant Appeal.
- 6. That, the Appellant has not come to the Court with clean hands and has suppressed material facts from this Honorable Tribunal.
- 7. That, the Appeal of the Appellant is time barred.

ON FACTS

- 5. Denied as stated. In fact, the answering Respondents carried out a thorough revision of the Service Rules of various cadres of the employees of Labour Department in order to make it in line with the contemporary requirements and to afford equal avenues of career progression to certain cadres to bring parity in the Service Rules and treat all of its employees alike. With this in mind, the post of Senior Scale Stenographer-cum-Judgment Writer as well as Computer Operator which either had no or an enormous, rather unjust, period of qualifying service for promotion previously, were placed in the stream of promotion along with Assistant since all of the posts carry equal Basic Pay Scale and the ultimate nature of their job upon seniority too has great resemblance. Moreover, it is also intimated for the kind appraisal of the Hon'ble Tribunal that the entire process of the under reference amendments was carried out in a lawful and formal manner having representation of both Establishment and Law Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa which approved the proposals on 22.03.2023 subsequent which the same were notified in the Official Gazette on 19.10.2023 (Annex-I&II). Furthermore, the posts of Senior Scale Stenographers and Computer Operators are commonly placed in the stream of promotion of Superintendents at various Directorates of Deptts, of the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Hence, the notion of petitioners is irrational and based on lack of knowledge.
- 6. Incorrect, hence denied. As elaborated in the preceding Para, the purpose of the amendments in the Service Rules of employees working in Labour Courts across the Province was providing equal opportunities of career progression to the incumbents of various posts which is primarily interlinked with the ultimate objective of public service delivery.
- 7. Correct to the extent that the appellant having felt aggrieved of the amendments pertaining to the insertion/inclusion of the posts of Senior Scale Stenographer-cum-Judgment Writer as well as Computer Operator in the Service Rules of employees of Labour Courts notified in October 2023, submitted Departmental Appeals to the worthy Chief Secretary Khyber Pakhtunkhwa who afforded them personal hearing through the then Secretary to Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Elementary & Secondary Education Department. However, the plaintiffs could neither put forth substantial proof against their standpoint nor convinced the Hearing Officer with solid arguments and due to the very reason their Departmental Appeals/Representation were turned down which was accordingly notified on 23.07.2024 and intimated to the plaintiffs (Annex-III).
- 8. Incorrect, hence denied. It was clearly inscribed in the Departmental Order dated 23.07.2024 that the appellant could neither convince the Hearing Officer through their assertions against the notified amendments in Service Rules as referred to in Paras-5 and 6, above, nor could they prove that the answering Respondents had acted upon in a contravening manner or with ill intents.

GROUNDS:-

- A. Incorrect, hence denied. The answering Respondents have acted upon in a formal, just and fair manner either without contravening any standards of merit or compromising the due rights of any of the employees of the Labour Courts, including the present plaintiffs as they have equal chances of promotions in the newly notified Service Rules.
- B. Incorrect, hence denied. The answering respondents have carried out the entire process of amendments of the Service Rules of the employees of Labour Courts in a lawful manner and have also afforded them sufficient opportunity afterwards to establish their viewpoint in accordance with the principles of nature justice.
- C. Incorrect, hence stated. Unlike assertions of the plaintiffs, the answering Respondents had been formally requested by the Presiding Officers of Labour Courts, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, who are the actual representatives of allied employees i.e Superintendents, Assistants, Computer Operators etc. had duly approached the Secretary to Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Labour Department in writing for making out amendments in the Service Rules of the employees of Labour Courts (Annex-IV). As regards representation in the Standing Service Rules Committee (SSRC), meeting, it is humbly submitted for the kind appraisal of the Hon'ble Tribunal that the very forum has its own composition given the fact that the official business is conducted in a systemized manner and not on the wishes or whims of an individual or individuals.
- D. Incorrect, hence denied. As referred to in the preceding Paras, the answering Respondents have neither contravened any law nor breached any articles of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
- E. Incorrect, hence denied. The inclusion of the incumbent officials other than the post of Assistant in the stream of promotion is neither unprecedented nor against the practice in vogue. Likewise, it is also expected that such a move would nourish the potential of incumbent officials and elevate the quality of work at the respective Courts which is an ultimate objective of the public service delivery.

- Incorrect, hence denied. As referred to in Para-5 of the "Facts" above, the incumbents of various posts gain sufficient experience of the office management with passage of time and get adequately acquainted with the business & requirements of a certain post. Hence, presumption of the plaintiffs that an administrative post could be managed only by the incumbents of his service cadre is neither rational nor the same would create any administrative hitches. As regards occupation of a post by promotion, the same is a common cycle whereby each eligible individual gets the post on his turn.
- J. Incorrect, hence denied. Reply has been given in the preceding Para.
- K. Denied as stated. Detailed reply has been given in Para-5 of the "Facts", above.
- Incorrect, hence denied. No rights of the plaintiffs have been infringed by the answering Respondents.

- M. Incorrect, hence denied. The administrative Department has acted upon in a legitimate way and has never encroached or violated its specified mandate.
- N. Incorrect, hence denied. The answering Respondents strictly believe in upkeeping the highest standards of merit and have acted upon in accordance with the very spirit while carrying out the necessary amendments in the Service Rules of the employees of Labour Courts of the province.
- O. Incorrect, hence denied. The answering Respondents have not contravened any Article of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

Meeting of the Standing Service Rules Committee (centralized) was held on 22.03.2023 at 11:00 AM under the chairmanship of Special Secretary (Regulation), Establishment Department in his office in order to discuss framing of service rules as well as to look into the proposed amendments in the existing service rules of the following Administrative Departments:-

- 1. Administration Department.
- 2. Labour Department.
- 3. Elementary & Secondary Education Department.

The chair welcomed participants and formally spelled out the purpose of the meeting. Thereafter, agenda items of the following departments were discussed and the representatives of the departments were asked to brief the forum on the proposed amendments in their respective agenda items.

Administration Department.

Agenda: Service rules for newly created post of Khadim (BPS-03) in Civil Officer's Mess Peshawar, Administration Department.

Representative of Administration Department while explaining the agenda-item apprised the forum that Finance Department has created post of Khadim in Civil Officer's Mess Peshawar, of Administration Department which needs to be included in the existing Service Rules as amendment.

After threadbare discussion, the forum unanimously approved Service Rules for the newly created post of Khadim in Civil Officer's Mess, Peshawar as appended at Appendix-I.

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Agenda: Framing of Service Rules for the Ministerial staff of Labour Court, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Representative of Labour, Department apprised the forum that existing service rules of Labour Courts were notified on 10.03/1996 which were subsequently amended to the extent of different posts on 02.06.2015. In the recent past Labour Department has been segregated from the conglomeration of Industries, Commerce, Mineral Development and Transport Departments. Therefore, all previous notifications issued in this behalf have been superseded by the Administrative Department in consultation with Establishment Department and Finance Department and proposed fresh service rules for the posts borne on the cadre strength of Labour Courts in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Representative of Administrative Department further informed that in the previous service rules, there exists a post of Stenographer (BS-16) that needs to be re-designated as Senior Scale Stenographer-Cum-Judgment writer (BS-16).

After threadbare discussion, the forum agreed to the proposal of the Administrative Department subject to the condition that the re-designated post i.e Senior Scale Stenographer-cum-Judgment writer (BPS-16) be duly reflected in the budget book of Finance Department.

Representative of the Administrative Department further proposed to create avenues for Muharrirs (BPS-07) by creating a post of Senior Clerk (BPS-14), wherein the Chair directed the representative to take up the case with Finance Department for creation of the post of Junior Clerk (BPS-11) in those Labour Courts where it does not exist.

After detailed discussion, the forum unanimously agreed upon the proposed service rules for various cadres in the Labour Courts of Labour Department as appended at Appendix-II.

Elementary & Secondary Education Department.

Agenda: Amendment in the Service Rules of Management Cadre under the Directorate of Elementary & Secondary Education and Curriculum & Teacher Education Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Representative of the Administrative Department explained that a new directorate namely, Directorate of Professional Development (DPD) by merging all the teachers training institutions has been formed to cater for the need of teachers training; this necessitated amendments in the existing service rules of Management Cadre. It is therefore, need of the hour to amend the existing service rules for enhancing professional skills of the workforce working in Elementary & Secondary Education Department. Moreover, SMC being a generalized training course does not meet requirement of the officers/teachers in the department. Therefore, instead of SMC, domain specific courses may be prescribed by the Directorate of Professional Development (DPD) and the officers will undergo trainings at DPD in their respective fields.

The forum, after threadpare discussion, unanimously agreed upon the proposed service rules as appended at Appendix-III.

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The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from the Chair.



That, Joint Service Rules for the Employees of Labour Appellate Tribunal and Labour Courts in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa were framed by the Provincial Government in the year 1996 and were amended in the year 2015, vide Notification No. SOL(LD)5-50/2015 Dated:02/06/2015

The Committee deeply examined existing Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Labour Courts Employees Service Rules, and proposed suitable amendments. It is further clarified that as per new / existing requirements, these Service Rules are become impracticable day-by-day hence instead of amendment, Repeal of Old Rules is necessary because apart from the other issues, several anomalies are also amendment incorporated in light of yesterday meeting due to inadvertent act of the Competent Authority. The draft / proposed amendments are made integral part of these minutes. The committee observed that the post of Computer Operator have already

been sanctioned in favour of Labour Court, Swat & D.I.Khan, however the committee recommends creation / sanction-of at least one Computer Operator for Labour Court, Haripur, Mardan & Peshawar. The committee expect an early action by the competent authority regarding incorporation
