


ORDER

1. Petitioner alongwith his counsel present. Mr. Arshad Azam, Assistant Advocate alongwith Mr. Naeem Ullah, Registrar for the respondents present.
 2. Representative of the respondents produced a copy of the order dated 15.10.2024, vide which the petitioner was reinstated into service with all back benefits. The petitioner stated that despite the reinstatement order dated 08.08.2024, his salary had not been released. In response, representative of the respondents stated that, at the time, a Civil Petition for Leave to Appeal (CPLA) had been filed by the department, and the suspension of the reinstatement order was in effect. Consequently, the Accountant General required an undertaking from the petitioner, stating that, in case of success of CPLA, petitioner would repay the withdrew amount during the intervening period. This undertaking, however, was not submitted, due to which petitioner's salary was not released. He further stated that now pending CPLA filed by the department is dismissed by the Supreme of Pakistan vide order dated 26.09.2024, therefore, now no such undertaking is required and salary of the petitioner will be released in the next month as the source has already been sent by the department.
 3. As the judgment of this Tribunal is satisfied, therefore, instant petition be disposed of. However, the petitioner is at liberty to file petition again, if his salary was not released. Consign.
