OTHER RELIEF WHICH THIS HONORABLE TRIBUNAL MAY DEEMS FIT AND PROPER IN THE CIRCUMSTANCE OF THE CASE MAY ALSO BE GRANTED TO THE APPELLANT.

Respectfully Sheweth;

The facts forming the back grounds of instant service appeal are arrayed as under;-

1. That the appellant was serving as LHC and was posted at Kas Pull Check post Battagram.
2. That on 23/04/2024, the appellant was present inside the Kas pull check post Battagram and some unknown assailants murdered, one Policeman, Namely Constable Amjad Hussain No. 18. The appellant after hearing the firing on the main gate came out from the check post and found constable Amjad Hussain No. 18 seriously injured. Copy of FIR No. 138 Police Station City Battagram dated 23/04/2024 is annexed as Annexure "A".

3. That the appellant as per law, proceeded and taken the injured/dead body of constable Amjad Hussain No.18 to the Hospital at near about 04:00 Am. But respondent No.3 without conducting proper inquiry, issuing show cause notice and statement of allegations, the appellant was dismissed from service after half an hour vide dismissal order dated 23/04/2024. Copy of dismissal order of the appellant from service dated 23/04/2024 is annexed as Annexure "B".

4. That feeling aggrieved, the appellant filed departmental appeal to respondent No.2 on 08/05/2024 which was rejected by respondent No.2 on 27/06/2024. Copy of departmental appeal dated 08/05/2024 and rejection order dated 23/06/2024 are annexed as Annexure "C" & "D". Thereafter, the appellant filed review petition before respondent No.1 vide departmental representation dated 10/07/2024. Copy of review petition of the appellant is annexed as Annexure "E".

5. That respondent No.1 partially allowed the review representation and re-instated the appellant in service with immediate effect and converted major penalty of dismissal from service into major punishment of reduction to time scale constable and the intervening period was converted into extra ordinary leave, leave without pay vide order dated 09/10/2024 which was received by the appellant on 17/10/2024. Copies of both the letter dated 09/10/2024 & 17/10/2024 are annexed as Annexure "F". Hence, the instant service appeal is filed inter-alia on the following ground.

GROUND:-

- a) That the appellant after performing his duties at night on 23/04/2024 was taking rest inside the Kas pull check post. Constable Amjad Hussain was on duty at the gate of the Kas pull check post who was murdered by unknown assailants on 23/04/2024 at 03:45 AM. After hearing the indiscriminate firing, the appellant came out and found that

constable Amjad Hussain was seriously injured and the appellant did not see any terrorist/assailant in dark and immediately took the necessary measures as per Police Rules but on the same date and at the spot, respondent No.3 dismissed the appellant from service vide dismissal from service order dated 23/04/2024.

- b) That the respondents did not follow the prescribed procedure which is sine quo non prior to the imposing of major penalties. Therefore dismissal order as well as reduction in time as Constable and treating the intervening period as Extra-Ordinary leave, leave without pay is liable to be set-aside.
- c) That the appellant is innocent as he was taking rest in Kas pull check post after performing his duties at night but respondents' department without conducting proper inquiry, issuing statement of

allegation, show cause notice, and without affording opportunity of personal hearing dismissed the appellant from service as and when occurrence took place at Kas pull check post Battagram. That on making representation to respondent No.1 the appellant was re-instated in service and the punishment of dismissal from service was converted into reduction in time scale constable and the intervening period has been converted into extra ordinary leave, leave without pay which is perverse, discriminatory and against the law and the impugned letter dated 09/10/2024 and 17/10/2024 is liable to be set-aside.

- d) That the respondents' department has led the appellant to the place which is utterly unknown to the principle of jurisprudence, good governance, fair play and natural justice.

- e) That this fact may not be left to fade in oblivion that the appellant was innocent and has been awarded major penalty without any reason and justification. Therefore, the impugned order dated 09/10/2024 and 17/10/2024 are liable to be cancelled.
- f) That the matter pertains to terms and condition of service. Hence according to article 212 (2) of the constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973 this Honourable Tribunal has jurisdiction to entertain the instant service appeal.
- g) That instant service appeal of the appellant is well within the period of limitation.
- h) That other grounds shall be urged at the time of arguments with the permission of this Honourable Tribunal.




serve the department like that of punctual officer. Hence, the impugned order is liable to set aside.




This order will dispose of departmental appeal under Rule 11-A of Khyber Pakhtunkawa Police Rules, 1975 submitted by Ex-LHC Abdul Khaliq No. 592 of District Battagram against the order of punishment i.e. dismissal from service awarded by DPO, Battagram vide OB No.26 dated 23-04-2024.

“Brief facts leading to the punishment are that the appellant while posted at Kass Pull check post Battagram absented himself from official duty without any leave/permission. On 23.04.2024 at about 03:45 hours some unknown person/persons opened fire on Constable Amjad Hussain No.18/Ex-Serviceman while he was on sentry duty at Kass Pull check post. The constable embraced Shahadat on the spot. The accused got escaped after the occurrence and took away the SMG of martyred constable. In this regard a case vide FIR No.138, dated 23.04.2024 u/s 6/7 ATA, 302 PPC was registered in PS City Battagram.”

The appellant failed to advance any cogent reason in his defense. Consequently, DPO Battagram awarded him major punishment of dismissal from service during summary proceedings. Hence, the appellant submitted this present appeal.

After receiving his appeal, comments of DPO Battagram were sought and examined/perused. The undersigned called the appellant in Orderly Room and heard him in person and provided him reasonable opportunity of defend the charges leveled against him. However, he failed to advance any reasonable justification in his defense. Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the undersigned under Rule 11-4 (a) of Khyber Pakhtunkawa Police Rules, 1975 the instant appeal is hereby *rejected/filed* with immediate effect.






