Service Appeal No.1149/2024 titled "Noor Shah Vs. Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa"

<u>ORDER</u>

Kalim Arshad Khan, Chairman: Learned counsel for the appellant present. Heard.

- 2. This appeal is with the prayer to set aside the order dated 04.07.2024, whereby, his application for correction of date of birth was not entertained being filed after more than two years of his entry into service. Learned counsel for the appellant was confronted with the situation to which he submitted that the date of birth mentioned in the service record was not tallying with the date of birth entered in the CNIC.
- 4. Record reflects that since the appellant has retired from service on 30.06.2024 on superannuation. Secondly, the contention of the appellant that date of birth was different in the CNIC and the service record is also not tenable because the service record, especially, medical certificate prepared at the time of appointment has to be given precedence. Last but not the least, Rule-116 of the General Financial Rules does not permit the request for correction of date of birth, if made after two years from entry into service.
- 5. In view of the above, instant service appeal is dismissed in limine. Consign.
