



Prayer in appeal:

On acceptance of this appeal the appellant may kindly be declared fit and eligible for the post Superintendent BPs-17 according to the rules, eligibility for the post of Superintendent BPS-17, and necessary direction may also be issued the respondents that the appellant may kindly be promoted to the post of Superintendent from the date when become eligible for promotion to the post of Superintendent BPS-17, the reluctance of the respondents by not promoting the appellant is illegal, unlawful and without lawful authority

Or any other remedy which is not specifically asked for may also be awarded in favor of the appellant.

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Respectfully Submitted:

1. That the appellant is working in the respondent department on the post of Assistant (BPS-16)
2. That since his appointment the appellant is performing his duties with great zeal, devotion and to the entire satisfaction of his superiors without any complaint whatsoever regarding his performance till date.
3. That while serving in the said capacity the respondent department issued a notification on 25.09.2019 that the post of superintendent BPS-17 can be filled by promotion on basis of seniority cum fitness from amongst the Assistants and Senior Scale Stenographer with at least five years service as such. *(Copy of notification dated 29.09.2019 is attached as annexure A).*
4. That the department issued final seniority list of Assistant BPS-16 and Senior Scale Stenographer BPS-16 on 10.08.2020, wherein the appellant was at serial No 16 in the seniority list and the respondent department have 22 vacant posts of superintendent BPS-17. *(Copy of the seniority list and detail vacant posts are attached as annexure B & C).*
5. That the vacant posts of Superintendent BPS-17 were available in the respondent department but the respondent department did not consider the appellant for promotion on the vacant post despite of his eligibility.
6. That being aggrieved the appellant approached the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Service Tribunal Peshawar in Appeal No 3397/2021 which was decided on 5/10/2023 in favor of the appellant. *(Copy of the appeal and order & judgment dated 05.10.2023 are attached as annexure D & E).*
7. That the appellant submitted an application along with order and judgment of this honorable tribunal but in vain thereafter the appellant filed an execution Petition No 149/2024 before the service tribunal which was decided on 07/06/2024. *(Copy of the execution petition and order dated 07.06.2024 are attached as annexure F)*
8. That the appellant filed a departmental appeal before the competent authority for his promotion vide appeal dated

09.07.2024 which is not yet responded even after the laps of statutory period of 90 days. *(Copy of the departmental appeal is attached as annexure G).*

9. That the appellant feeling aggrieved from the acts and omission of the respondents filed this service appeal on the following grounds amongst the others:

GROUND OF SERVICE APPEAL:

- A. That the appellant has not been treated in accordance with law and hence his rights secured and guaranteed under law and constitution are badly violated.
- B. That appellant having all the requisite eligibility criteria for further promotion to the post of Superintendent BPS-17 according to the rules/quota,
- C. That according to the rules for promotion the post of Superintendent BPS-17 shall be filled on the basis of Seniority cum fitness amongst the Assistants and Senior Scale Stenographers, the appellant is under the promotion quota.
- D. That according to the rules the following criteria has been specified for promotion to the post of Superintendent BPS-17.

- E. That the appellant at earlier round of litigation approached to this honorable Tribunal for consideration of promotion in which the honorable tribunal directed the respondent to considered his case, upon which they turn deaf ears, the appellant was compelled to file execution petition which was also disposed of upon the misstatement of the department, whereas they declined the promotion on the basis that all the posts of Superintendent BPS-17 are pre occupied/ filled and there is no vacant post against which the appellant can be considered.
- F. That according to the budget book regarding vacancies in the social welfare and special education department, whereas there are 34 number of Budgeted positions, in which 17 positions are Vacant, which can cover up to 17 candidates who fulfilled the eligibility criteria for promotion to the post of Superintendent BPS-17.
- G. That the respondent department issued the seniority list/final way back in the year 2020 but did not exclude the promoted and retired employees and made it ambiguous to mislead this honorable tribunal, as earlier done in the first round of litigation and till date the same seniority is available within the department.
- H. That the respondent department malafidly with ulterior motive not promoting the appellant to the post of Superintendent BPs-17 to give undue benefit to their blue eyed ones and deprived the present appellant from his due right of promotion as secured and guaranteed by the constitution of Pakistan as well as the service rules of the respondent department.
- I. That the whole service career of the appellant has been put at stake as the long earned seniority maturing her right of promotion to the next scale has been blocked.


- J. That it is pertinent to mentioned here that Junior Colleagues of the appellant were promoted to the post of Superintendent BPS-17 but the same was denied to the present appellant which is illegal, unlawful and violative upon the rights of the appellant.
- K. That the appellant has not been treated as per notified gazetted rules by the respondents which deprived the appellant from her due right of seniority, promotion.
- L. That under Article 25 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973, all citizen are equal before law, and that no discrimination is permitted in the similarly placed citizens, thus the discrimination meted out to the appellant by not promoting he appellant to the post of Superintendent BPS-17 is illegal, highly discriminatory and not sustainable.
- M. That the Superior Courts have repeatedly held that where a point of law is decided by the Superior Courts that cover the cases of all those civil servants who have not litigated than the good governance require that the benefit of such judgment should also be given to those who may not be parties to the litigation instead of compelling them to approach the Service Tribunal or any other forum. Reference can be made to case reported as SCMR 1996 Page 1185, 2009 SCMR Page 1, the petitioner being similarly placed are also entitled to similar treatment meted out to their counter parts.
- N. That the state is bound to ensure the elimination of all forms of exploitation and the gradual fulfillment of the fundamental principles. It is also the duties of the state to remove disparity in the income and earning of individuals under Article 37 & 38 of the Constitution.
- O. That the Hon' able Supreme Court of Pakistan in case reported as 2010-SCMR-1301, has held that in matter of seniority, promotion, rules are to be followed and where the discretion of authority is involved, then that must be exercised with fairness. It is also held in the said judgment that promoting the juniors by ignoring seniors will not advance the object of achieving good governess. It is further pointed out in the said judgment that the Constitution is the supreme law and there is no room to allow the authority to make departure from law, rules and Article 4 and 25 of the constitution.

- P. That even in latest judgment of the Hon' able Supreme Court reported as PLD 2013 (SC)-195. (Case of Anita Turab), it is held that the statutory provisions, rules, regulations which govern the matter of appointment, Promotion of Civil Servants must be followed honestly and scrupulously.
- Q. That any other ground would be taken at the time of arguments with the prior permission of this honourable tribunal.

It is, therefore, humbly prayed that On acceptance of this appeal the appellant may declared fit and eligible for the post Superintendent BPs-17 according to the rules, eligibility for the post of Superintendent BPS-17, and necessary direction may also be issued the respondents that the appellant may kindly be promoted to the post of Superintendent from the date when become eligible for promotion to the post of Superintendent BPS-17, the reluctance of the respondents by not promoting the appellant is illegal, unlawful and without lawful authority .



FACTS:

1. That the appellant is working the respondent department as Assistant (BPS-16) and performing his duty with great devotion and honesty, whatsoever, assigned to him and no complaint has been filed against the appellant regarding his performance.
2. That the respondent department issued circular/notification on 25.09.2019, wherein the post of superintendent (BPS-17) can be filled by promotion on basis of seniority-cum-fitness from amongst the Assistants and Senior Scale Stenographer with at least five years service as Such. (Copy of circular/notification dated 29.09.2019 is attached as Annexure-A)
3. That the department issued final seniority list of Assistant (BPS-16) and Senior Scale Stenographer (BPS-16) on 10.08.2020, wherein the appellant is at Sr. No.16 in that seniority list and the respondent department have 22 vacant posts of superintendent (BPS-17), which is evident from payroll of April 2020. (Copies of seniority list and detail of vacant post from payroll of April 2020 are attached as Annexure-B&C)
4. That the vacant posts of superintendent (BPS-17) are available in the respondent department, but the respondent department did not consider the appellant for promotion on those vacant posts despite his eligibility, therefore, the appellant departmental appeal, which was properly forwarded by respondent No. 3 to respondent No.2 through letter dated 08.10.2020 for further necessary action, however, no action has taken on the departmental appeal of the appellant within the statutory period of ninety days. (Copy of departmental appeal and letter are attached as Annexure-D&E)
5. That now the appellant has no other remedy expect to file the instant appeal in this Honourable Tribunal for redressal of his grievances on the following grounds.

GROUND:

- A. That not considering the appellant for promotion to the post of superintendent (BPS-17) and not taking action on the departmental appeal of the appellant within the statutory period of ninety days are against the law, facts, norms of justice and material on record, therefore, not tenable.
- B. That the posts of superintendent (BPS-17) are available in the respondent department and the appellant has legitimate exception for promotion on those available posts, but the respondent department did not consider the appellant for promotion to the post of Superintendent

ATTESTED

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(BPS-17) on those available posts, which is violation of principle of legitimate expectancy.

- C. That the appellant is at Sr. No.16 in the seniority list of Assistant (BPS-16) and 22 posts of Superintendent (BPS-17) are vacant in the respondent department, but not considering the appellant for promotion to the post of Superintendent (BPS-17) despite his eligibility shows the arbitrary manner of the respondents.
- D. That rules for promotion to the post of Superintendent (BPS-17) is still in field and the appellant is eligible for promotion to the post of Superintendent (BPS-17), therefore the appellant has legal right to be consider for promotion to the post of Superintendent (BPS-17) under the circular/notification dated 25.09.2019.
- E. That Hon'able Supreme Court of Pakistan has also held in many cases that promotion quota will always to be made when the post was available for an officials in his quota and the official cannot be deprived from his rights merely because the concern department did not carry out the process of promotion, therefore not considering the appellant for promotion to the post of Superintendent (BPS-17) is clear violation of superior court judgments.
- F. That depriving the appellant from his legal right of promotions to the post of Superintendent (BPS-17) will suffer him a lot, both in future promotion chances as well as monetary benefits in the shape of pension and gratuities.
- G. That the appellant has not been treated according to law and rules and has been kept deprived from his genuine right of promotion in an arbitrary manner.
- H. That the appellant seeks permission to advance others grounds and proofs at the time of hearing.







Disposed of accordingly. Consign."

The prayer made in the appeal was for direction to the respondents to consider the appellant/petitioner for promotion to the post of Superintendent while the order passed by the Tribunal was direction of consideration of the appellant/petitioner for promotion in the next DPC when that was held. The department has filed written reply, wherein, it was stated there were five sanctioned posts of Office Superintendent (BPS-17) which were already filled, while the appellant/petitioner was at Serial No.5 of the seniority list and may be promotion on his turn on the basis of rules.

Respectfully, with reference to the subject noted above, some points are submitted for your perusal and favorable consideration please:

1. That presently I am working as Assistant (BPS-16) in Government Institute for Children with Hearing & Speech Impairments Charsadda. According to serial No.10 of the service rules notified vide Notification No. SOII/SWD/11-12/Service Rules/2019-20/320-52 dated 25-09-2019 (See Annexure-A) the post of superintendent (BPS-17) is to be filled as under:

"By promotion on the basis of seniority -cum-fitness from amongst the Assistant and Senior Scale Stenographer with at least five years service as such Note. A joint seniority list of assistant and senior scale stenographer shall be maintained for the purpose of the seniority.

2. According to the Budget book 2024-25 there are a total of 34 sanctioned posts of Superintendent B-17, out of which more than 20 posts are lying vacant. (Annexure-B).
3. According to the seniority list issued vide No.E-17/17/OSW/Vol-6/1160-65 dated 10/05/2020 (Annexure-C) a number of incumbents of the post of assistant and senior scale stenographer (BPS-16) are eligible for promotion as per mentioned above.
4. The applicant submitted a written application for promotion but no action was taken on the subject matter.
5. Feeling aggrieved the applicant filed a writ petition No3397/2021(Annexure-D) before the Provincial Service Tribunal KP Peshawar on the subject matter the honorable services tribunal in its decision directed the department to consider the applicant in the next DPC(Annexure -E). The decision was submitted to directorate of SW for implementation/ consideration (Annexure -F), but again no action was taken by the department in due course of time.
6. Then the applicant, with no other choice, filed an Execution Petition No.149/2023(Annexure -G) before the Tribunal for implementation of the decision of the honorable court. During the arguments the honorable judge of services tribunal directed the department to produce the details of sanctioned posts of superintendent B-17 as per budget book 2023-24 and relevant service rules for filling the post of superintendent(Annexure -H) and other equivalent post on the next date. Unfortunately, the department submitted incomplete record in the court by showing in written that there were only five sanctioned posts(Annexure -I) which were already filled, contrary to the real position that there were 34 sanctioned posts of superintendents as per budget book 2023-24 (Annexure -B) as mentioned above. In implementation case the honorable court stands with his previous decision that the applicant should be consider in the next DPS when it held.(Annexure-J)

In the light of above justification it is therefore requested again that kindly consider my case for promotion to the post of superintendent (B-17) against any vacant post and oblige please
